- a. Approval of a recommendation to the Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE) for its approval of the CPE Policy on the Hope Scholarship (Enclosure 3)
 - i. Greg Ebner, Assistant Commissioner for Academics and Student Affairs, presented the proposed CPE Policy on the Hope Scholarship.
 (1) The proposed CPE policy is required by the legislation creating

- the Hope Scholarship (RIGL 16-112).
- (2) The proposed CPE policy closely aligns with the legislation creating the scholarship. In some places, the policy adds information about resources or points of contact. It also expands the reporting requirements to allow for improved assessment of performance indicators.
- (3) The proposed CPE policy also aligns with the Rhode Island College Hope Scholarship Policy Handbook, recommended for approval at the October 4, 2023 meeting of the AASSC.
- (4) The proposed CPE policy has been reviewed by staff and leadership at Rhode Island College who are responsible for execution of scholarship. OPC attained approval of the policy from those parties as part of the drafting process.
- (5) In response to a question from Lawrence Purtill, Greg Ebner explained that unforeseen circumstances not addressed in the policy would be adjudicated by the Commissioner.
- (6) Cindy Kozil reported that RIC had spent approximately \$2.36 million on the scholarship to this point.
- (7) In response to Chairman Mello's questions, RIC personnel provided the following answers:
 - 1. RIC expects up to 400 Hope Scholarship students in the 2024-2025 school year.
 - 2. The maximum expenditure of the Hope Scholarship is \$400 million per year
