Out-of state students are eligible to participate in the Joint Admissions Agreement (JAA) and to receive the merit-based Joint Admission Academic Achievement Award (JA-AAA) provided that all of the program eligibility requirements are met. The amount of the award for out-of state students will be calculated using in-state tuition rates. The award will be applied only to the student's out-of-state tuition costs.
