3. Discussion Item

a. Notices of Change (Community College of Rhode Island)

i. Creation of Photography Certificate

CCRI Dean of Student Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences, William Stargard briefed the Committee on the Photography Certificate. He announced that although the college was currently offering the course, the courses would not be included in the college's course catalog until next year. Mr. Stargard answered Committee Member Lawrence Purtill's question about accessibility to equipment, stating that the school would loan equipment to the students taking the course. Mr. Stargard indicated that the program would overlap video

and digital art, combining aspects from departments such as photography, communications, and media. Mr. Stargard confirmed that students would be eligible receive an associate's degree while participating in this course.

b. Hope Scholarship Annual Report (Rhode Island College)

Interim Director of Hope Scholarship Jennifer L. Boulay gave a brief presentation of the overview of RIC's data on the Hope Scholarship. Discussions included gender distribution, with an emphasis on increasing enrollment of males of color. Reasons for student attrition were noted, and the complexity of defining full-time status and its impact on graduation timelines was addressed by Ms. Boulay. She also discussed the financial aspects including scholarship eligibility and avoiding punitive policies for students requiring additional time. Lastly, Ms. Boulay informed the Committee on the fiscal implications, with state costs estimated at \$4 million and federal aid data provided for informational purposes.

4. Action Items

a. Proposed Change to Policy on Athletics

Assistant Commissioner Gregory Ebner presented an overview of the proposed change to the Policy on Athletics. Assistant Commissioner Ebner highlighted the proposed changes in language and addressed the updated roles and responsibilities the school and of the President.
