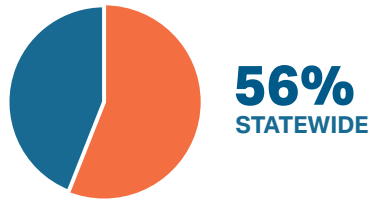
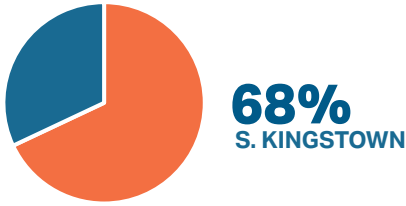

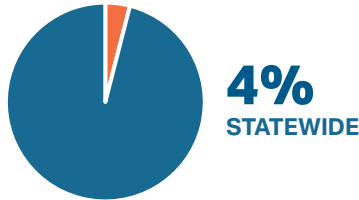
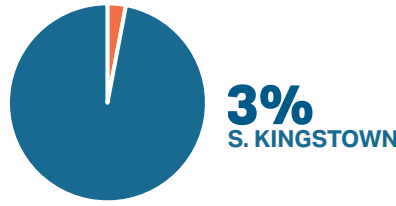
FAFSA COMPLETION RATES³

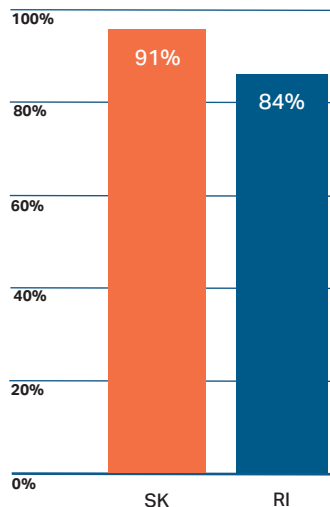

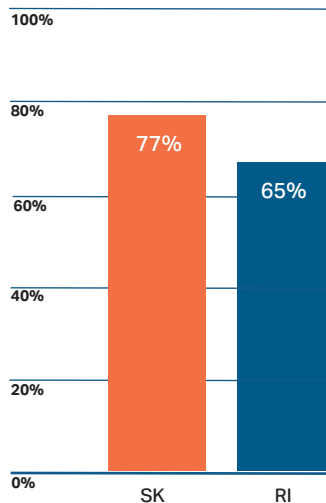
