ABOUT YOUR Student.Aid.gov ACCOUNT

- The first StudentAid.gov account you create will be the <u>only</u> StudentAid.gov account you will have. You will use it every time you apply for federal financial aid in the future. This means you can't simply create another StudentAid.gov account in the future.
- Each student & parent(s) must create a unique StudentAid.gov accounts with separate usernames, passwords, and email addresses for their exclusive use.
- Use a personal email address that you'll have access to in the future no matter what school you attend or where you work.
