



FAFSA COMPLETION RATES³




POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION TRANSITION⁴

6,436 RHODE ISLAND PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A DUAL AND/OR CONCURRENT COURSE. OF THOSE, **105 (2%)** WERE **BRISTOL-WARREN STUDENTS.**

\$10,289,501 IN SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO **7,856** STUDENTS. **82** OF WHOM WERE BRISTOL RESIDENTS. **\$1,310** WAS THE AVERAGE AWARD
