




Educational Attainment Age 25 and Over





**5-YEAR ATTAINMENT RATE<sup>1</sup>**

**6,436 RHODE ISLAND PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS** ENROLLED IN A DUAL AND/OR CONCURRENT COURSE. OF THOSE, **169 (3%) WERE CUMBERLAND STUDENTS.**

**\$10,289,501** IN SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO **7,856** STUDENTS **222** OF WHOM WERE CUMBERLAND RESIDENTS. **\$1,310** WAS THE AVERAGE AWARD
