

6,436 RHODE ISLAND PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A DUAL AND/OR CONCURRENT COURSE. OF THOSE, **87 (1%)** WERE **EAST GREENWICH STUDENTS.**

\$10,289,501 IN SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO **7,856** STUDENTS. **77** OF WHOM WERE EAST GREENWICH RESIDENTS. **\$1,310** WAS THE AVERAGE AWARD
