





6,436 RHODE ISLAND PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A DUAL AND/OR CONCURRENT COURSE. OF THOSE, **364 (6%)** WERE **EAST PROVIDENCE STUDENTS.**

\$10,289,501 IN SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO **7,856** STUDENTS. **329** OF WHOM WERE EAST PROVIDENCE RESIDENTS. **\$1,310** WAS THE AVERAGE AWARD
